

Make a Tissue Paper Poppy

Carry your poppy on Memorial Day to honor fallen soldiers.



What You Need:

- 1 black, 1 red sheet of tissue paper
- pencil
- 1 small, round lid or cup, for tracing
- 1 big, round lid or cup, for tracing
- scissors
- 1 green pipe cleaner

What You Do:

1. Trace three circles using the small lid or cup on the black paper. Cut out the circles and stack them.
2. Repeat step 1 with the big lid and red paper.
3. Center the black circles on top of the red circles.
4. Carefully poke the pipe cleaner through the center of the circles, pushing up from the bottom. Push through until about 1 inch of the pipe cleaner is poking up.
5. Bend the tip in half to make a hook shape in the center of the flower.
6. Hold the flower by the stem. Use your fingers to scrunch the tissue paper up. Fluff it out until the pipe cleaner tip is hidden in the black center.
