## Grocery Stores

**Grocery stores** have become an essential part of our every day lives. From these stores, we can access food, drinks, medicine, and other important items.



Often, when you enter a grocery store, you want to get a **cart** or **basket** that will hold all of your **groceries** while you shop. As you shop up and down the **aisles**, you may need help finding an item. If you need help, you can always ask an **employee**.

To make it easier to find items, there are different areas of a grocery store. The **produce** section is where all of the fresh fruit and vegetables are. Sometimes there is a **scale** in this

When you are all done shopping, you should head to the **register**. When you get there, you should put your items on the **belt** so that the **cashier** can add up the prices of your groceries. If you're lucky, you may even have a **coupon** to give to the cashier to save yourself some money. When the cashier is done adding up the prices of your items, you can pay using cash or a **credit card**. If you pay with cash, you may even get

some **change** back. It is always important to



count your change and check your **receipt** before you leave the store to make sure no one made any mistakes.




**Directions:** State the problem and present both solutions verbally. Circle or select the solution that makes the most sense.

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
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
